Well, the rain came and it obviously affected a number of venues yesterday.

## **Division 4 and below**

As per Rule 8.1.2 any match not started or abandoned before the required number of ends were completed (as per Rule 5.8) will be treated as a draw with game points shared equally and 2 shots awarded to each team.

As per the memo issued on 24 November 2019 it is the **home side's responsibility** to enter the scores for abandoned games – this is done by entering a score of 2 shots for both sides for each rink. As of Sunday morning there were a number of games with no scores entered. Can Clubs please enter these scores as soon as possible.

## **Premier League, Divisions 1, 2 & 3**

Any game not completed will be played, or resumed if some ends were played, next Friday (February 7<sup>th</sup>) with trial ends commencing at 6:00 pm.

A summary of the conditions that apply to resumed games is included on the next page of this document.

## Resumed games – rules of play

Please refer to the Laws of the Sport of Bowls – DR 2.1 & DR 2.3 for rules covering substitutes. A summary is included here.

- Games will resume from when they were abandoned with the same players, using the same score card;
- Two trial ends are permitted;
- If a player is unavailable a substitute may be used;
- A substitute must not have played in any other game in any other side in Round 13, even if that game had not been completed;
- A substitute must play in the same position as the player being substituted, except if it is the skip. If a substitute is required for a skip, then the other members must rearrange their positions as necessary (DR 2.4.5);
- Players must not be transferred from one team to another;
- Only one substitute is allowed in each team of a side;

If a substitute is unavailable, the team will continue the game as if the second player is missing (refer DR 2.5);
