**SUBJECT: Pennant Finals**

Finals will be played in the following Divisions:

**Wednesday:** Premier League, Division 1, Division 2 & Division 3

**Thursday:** Premier League, Division 1 & Division 2

**Saturday:** Premier League, Division 1, Division 2, Division 3, Division 4 & Division 5.

For all three pennant competitions, Wednesday, Thursday and Saturday, both Semi-Finals (1 v 2, 3 v 4) will be played at the venue of the Minor Premier. Preliminary Finals will be played at the venue of the higher ranked Club of the two competing sides.

Grand Finals will be played at neutral venues to be announced by the Match & Program Committee.

For all Semi-finals and Preliminary finals, Host Clubs are to provide a Manager and Umpires, preferably non-playing umpires.

All Finals matches will be played straight through, with no mid-game break.

Home sides, including the higher ranked side for those playing at a neutral venue, are responsible for entering results into BowlsLink by 6:30 pm on the day of play. Away sides will still need to confirm the results as usual.

Please Note: In past years a list of players and the number of games they have played in each side has been sent to Clubs to assist them in determining player eligibility for finals. This will not be done this season as the information is readily available from the Player/Skip ladder within the BowlsLink system.

Separate memos will be sent out for each of the competitions once finalists have been determined.
