## **Greetings! President to President.**

- **1. Congratulations!** The opening of the 'Orange Bowl' at Salisbury Bowling Club went well! The club now has a great all weather facility.
- 2. Welcome to the new Presidents! Greetings also as you are the delegate for your club to the MBA. We look forward to your participation in our meetings.
